\$2,500 Thoroughbred Recreational Riding Incentive Program Sponsor - The Thoroughbred Recreational Riding Incentive Program (TRRIP) is designed to recognize and reward Thoroughbred owners and riders who enjoy recreational riding or driving on a regular basis. Support Thoroughbreds in a non-competitive career through sponsorship of the TRRIP. Amount can include in-kind contribution of awards. Sponsorship benefits include:

State Bred or Residing Performance Award Sponsor – Thoroughbred breeder and owner organizations, horse councils and other state horse organizations are offered the opportunity to recognize Thoroughbreds that were bred and/or reside in their state that are exceling in a second career through a T.I.P. Performance Award, which are year-end, self-reported competition awards created to expand the reach of T.I.P. and allow riders in all states and Canadian provinces to participate even if horse shows in their area do not offer T.I.P. awards or do not offer awards in their discipline. Sponsorship choices include:

- 1. \$500 State Bred or Residing Performance Award Sponsor Winner of the award will be provided with a prize package including a ribbon, cooler, and halter, and ribbons will be provided through 6th place. Sponsorship includes announcement of sponsorship on Facebook and through T.I.P. electronic newsletter as well as recognition in the winners' list. Sponsor will be provided with a list of all eligible horses at the conclusion of the awards.
